Best Teaching Assistant Award for Graduate Students in Statistics

GUIDELINES

The Best Teaching Assistant Award ("the Award" thereafter) is the Department's recent endeavor to

honor and reward graduate students who make an effort in their teaching assistant activities. Most of

our graduate students choose a career in teaching after graduation. The Award formally recognizes

their excellence in teaching. The establishment of the award also builds on a philosophy that it can

enrich and stimulate quality education, as well as to facilitate the exchange of teaching experience

among our graduate students.

About the Award

The Department will select two graduate students every academic year (one student in each semester)

to receive the Award. Each award is valued up to HK\$1,000 with a certificate.

A. Eligibility

1. The nominee must be a current graduate student in Statistics at CUHK at the time of nomination.

2. The nominee has performed the Teaching Assistant duties for at least one semester in the past

academic year.

3. A student can only receive this award once in every two years.

B. Selection Processes and Criteria

The main criteria for being selected for the award are: (1) Teaching Assistant Evaluation results,

and (2) The comments from the instructors of the courses. The selection is made by the Graduate

Studies Panel in November of the next academic year.
